Vocabulary Enricher

Good Reader's Skill: Develop New Vocabulary

What does the Vocabulary Enricher do?

Good readers develop new vocabulary as they read. As Vocabulary Enricher, your job is to look for words your group can add to its vocabulary. They do not necessarily need to be words you don't already know. They can be words that are:

- Important
- Unfamiliar
- Puzzling
- Funny
- Interesting
- Used in an unusual way
- Different

Once you've found the word, record the page you found it on, the paragraph and sentence you found it in, and the meaning of that word. Also, create a sentence with enough context clues that your group members can discover the meaning of the word from the sentence. You should have at least 5 words.

Questions:

Each group member must come up with 5 open-ended questions for discussion on discussion day. Possible open-ended questions might start with:

- What might happen if...?
- How is... like...?
- How is... different from...?
- Do you agree with...? Why/why not?
- What feelings did you have when...?
- What was your first reaction to...?
- Do you think... should have...? Why/Why not?
