#### Credit for Classes:

Students can take one or both sessions for .50 unit of credit per session. USD 501 students must have referral forms from their counselors prior to enrolling in any summer course.

For Example: 1st session; Algebra = .50 unit.

Those enrolled in high school credit courses will receive a letter grade and a copy will be sent to the school specified by the student on the enrollment form.

#### Attendance:

Unless otherwise indicated, all classes will meet Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM. Students are expected to attend classes regularly and be in class on time. Attendance is checked three times each day. There is no distinction made between excused or unexcused absences. Any expected absences must be discussed with the principal prior to the absence.

Refunds are not given for non-attendance. No refunds are made after the 1st day of the 1st session.

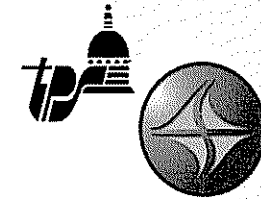
A LIMITED number of Topeka Public School Students currently enrolled and eligible for free or reduced lunches may be eligible for reduced fees through available scholarship money.
