



**Concurrent Enrollment Partnership (CEP)
Spring 2012 Information –Washburn Rural High
School**



High school juniors and seniors with at least a 3.0 GPA can earn up to 6 hours of college credit each semester at half the regular tuition rate through the ESO/CEP program (the Kansas Board of Regents permits a maximum of 24 CEP credit hours). **You must have the approval of your high school principal or counselor (and your parent or legal guardian if you're under 18) to enroll in these courses.** Follow the steps below to enroll in the Spring 2012 ESO/CEP program.

1. Attend the ESO/CEP orientation at your high school on the date shown below (parents are encouraged to attend).
2. Read the CEP Student Guide and related information at www.washburn.edu/eso.
3. Pick up a copy of the **Authorization and Enrollment Form** from your high school contact person shown below.
Highly qualified students may receive approval from the College of Arts and Sciences to enroll in more than six credit hours. However, your counselor must include a letter of support and a copy of your high school transcript with the enrollment form. The approval to enroll in more than six hours will be based upon these documents.
4. Complete the form, sign it, and have your parent or guardian sign it if you are under 18 years of age.
5. **Submit the completed form and tuition payment on the registration date shown below for your school, or to the WU Office of Academic Outreach in Benton Hall 408, by Friday, January 6, to avoid an administrative fee.** Enrollment forms must include the school official's signature and the tuition payment (check, credit card, or money order only). All forms submitted after January 6 must also include a \$50 non-refundable administrative fee in addition to the tuition.
6. The tuition is \$108 per credit hour, which is 50% of the regular undergraduate rate.
7. **No enrollments will be accepted, or tuition refunds issued, after January 27.**
8. Course textbooks required by WU will be available for sale online or for rent at your school in January.
