

# EISENHOWER-ANTHONY INVITATIONAL CROSS COUNTRY MEET INFORMATION

**Date: Saturday, September 24, 2011**

**Anneberg Park – Manhattan, KS**

**DIRECTIONS:** Anneberg Park is located in west Manhattan on Anderson Ave. **If coming from the east on I-70**, take exit 313 north to Manhattan. After crossing the bridge, take the exit right to Tuttle Creek Blvd. /Ft. Riley Blvd. and turn right to go around the south edge of Manhattan. Continue on Ft. Riley Blvd. (which turns into K-18 Highway) traveling west. Take the KS-113/Seth Child Road exit ramp. Travel a little over a mile on Seth Child Road and take the Anderson Ave. exit. Turn left on Anderson Ave. and travel 0.8 miles. You will turn left into the park. You will see soccer fields, a softball complex, a small lake and trail around all of it.

Dress for cold and wet weather. The school issued sweats and uniforms will be worn at all meets. You may also wear your Washburn Rural apparel that you bought. **Sweats will be handed out next week.**

**ESTIMATED** time home is 3:30 pm. BUT please be available for a phone call anytime after 2:00pm in case we arrive back early.

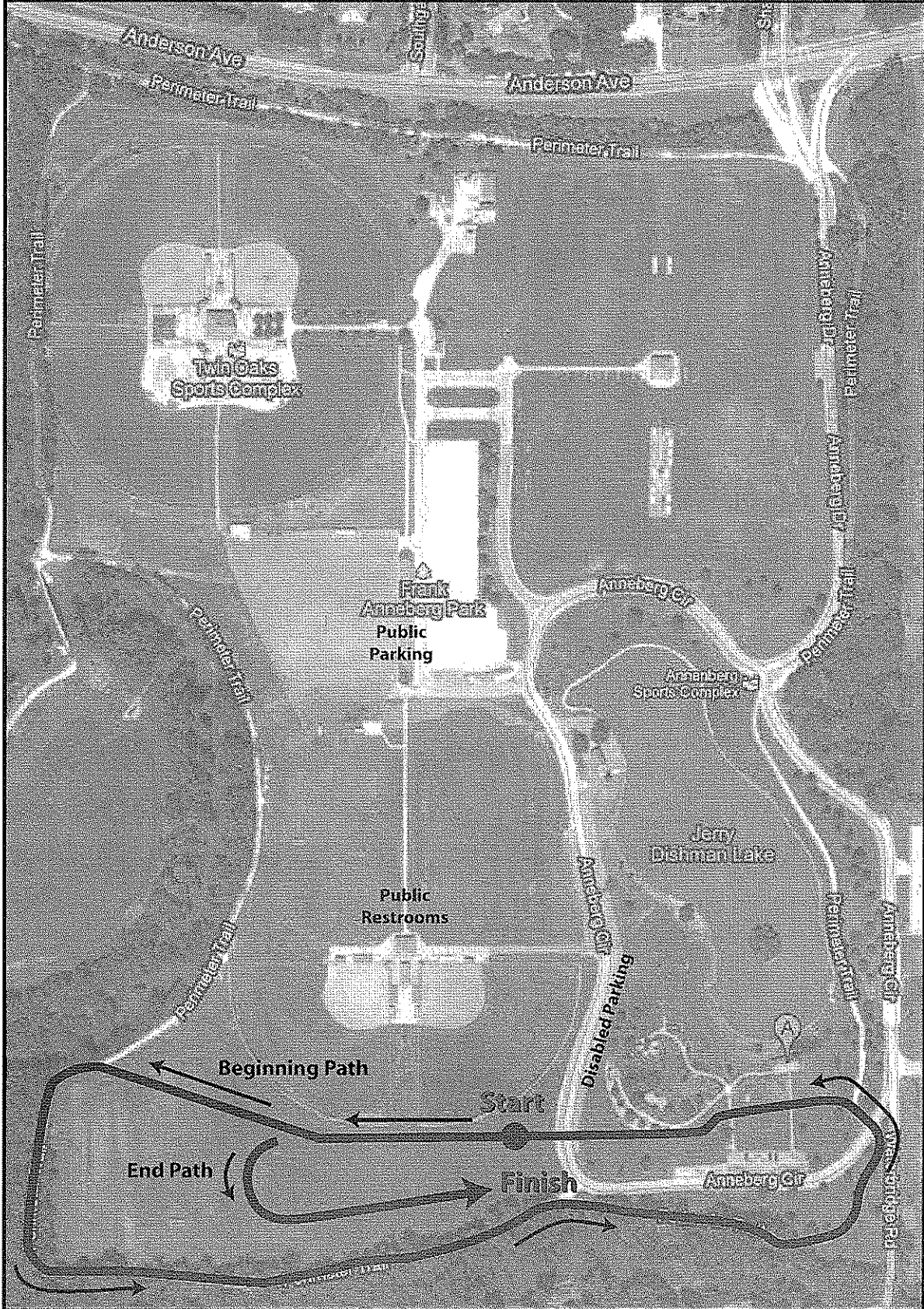
